1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kennington called the meeting to order at 12:00 Noon and welcomed all present.

2. Discussed and considered for approval modifications to the Pittsburg Home Buyers Program.

Increased assistance guidelines from \$2,000.00 to \$12,000.00, packets available at City Hall. To qualify must meet the low to moderate income ceiling, be able to verify their income and get a letter of loan pre-approval from a bank or mortgage company. The cost of the house will be between \$80,000.00 and \$90,000.00. The city will file a forgivable lien on the property for five (5) years. If home is not sold or transferred within that time period, the lien will be released on the five (5) year anniversary of the closing. If home is sold, a pro-rated portion of the down payment assistance will be recovered by the City. The contract is similar to the Habitat for Humanity contract.

Councilmember Ford made a motion to approve. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cook and carried unanimously.
