1. CALL TO ORDER

2. INVOCATION  
Mayor Kennington gave the invocation.
3. ORDINANCES/RESOLUTIONS
  - 3.1 Discussed and considered for approval on first reading an Ordinance amending prior Zoning Ordinance concerning Recreational Vehicle Parks.
