1. Mayor Kennington called the City's meeting to order at 12:30 P.M.

- 3. Mrs. Hull reported on the findings of the solution agreement that was approved by the Board of Directors to be sent to all of the entities for approval or disapproval. Eighty percent of the entities agreed with the document. The Pittsburg ISD did not pass the agreement. Mrs. Hull sent a letter to all entities and requested them to respond to each other with a solution to determine how to pass a resolution that would be agreeable to each entity.
- 4. Jim Lambeth, Delinquent Tax Attorney spoke on Pilgrim's situation.

Mr. Lambeth discussed Pilgrim Pride's financial status and what impact it could have on each entity. He stated there was a possibility that they might file bankruptcy. He stated that a restructuring officer had been hired to help the company begin a process of laying off employees. He stated that he believed that someone would indeed want to purchase the failing company if it would offer itself on the market. If the bankruptcy became reality payments to the entities could be delayed or reduced depending upon the judgment call of the courts. Mrs. Hull reported that about 20% of the entities funding was supplied by Pilgrim Pride. She stated that the entities could be looking at a collection rate of 76% this year instead of the 96% to 98% collections that have been collected in the past.
